TO VOTE: Completely darken the oval opposite each choice as shown: 

IMPORTANT: To mark your ballot, use only a black or blue ink pen. **DO NOT USE ANY OTHER INK COLOR!**

WHEN YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING: Place the ballot in the secrecy sleeve so that votes cannot be seen and the numbered stub is visible. Return the ballot to the election official stationed at the tabulator. (If voting by absentee ballot, follow the instructions provided by the clerk for returning the ballot.)

NOTE: If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the election official and obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.

PERRY PUBLIC SCHOOLS
BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Perry Public Schools, Shiawassee and Ingham Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Two Million Nine Hundred Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$2,990,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

partially remodeling, furnishing and refurbishing, equipping and re-equipping school facilities, in part, for energy conservation improvements; acquiring, installing and equipping technology for school facilities; and developing and improving sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

No millage will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2011 under current law. The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is thirty (30) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is .75 mill (\$0.75 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

If the school district borrows from the State to pay debt service on the bonds, the school district may be required to continue to levy mills beyond the term of the bonds to repay the State.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
